Directions:

From Berlin/Snow Hill/Ocean City: Drive north through Ocean City, Fenwick Island, and Bethany Beach. Turn left onto Fred Hudson Rd, then turn right onto Cedar Neck Rd. Turn left into the Preserve's parking lot.

From Salisbury: Go on Rt. 50 E toward Ocean City. Turn left onto Whaleyville Rd. Turn left onto Hammond Rd. Turn left onto Old Stage Rd, then turn right onto Hotel Rd. In Selbyville turn right onto Bethany Rd. In Ocean View turn right onto Burbage Rd, then left onto Windmill Dr, then right onto Atlantic Ave, and finally left onto Central Ave. The Preserve's parking lot is on your left.
