They work to understand the water household, clouds and how to predict weather. Others study the rocks and soil types, and some work to understand what lives on Earth. In this class you can learn about powerful geological and weather events such as volcanic eruptions, earthquakes, tornadoes, and Earth's magnetic field through many hands-on experiments. The recommended kids' age is 4 to 13 years. Please note that this is not a drop-off class. Parents/quardians are invited to participate together with their kids.

Directions:

From OC: Take Rt. 50W toward Berlin. Turn left onto Main Street to Berlin. Turn right onto Harrison Ave, then immediately turn right into the library parking lot.

From Salisbury: Take Rt 50 E toward Ocean City. Turn right onto Main Street to Berlin. Turn right onto Harrison Ave, then immediately turn right into the library parking lot.

From Snow Hill: Take Rt 113 N toward Berlin. At the Berlin ball field turn left onto S Main Street. Turn left onto Harrison Ave, then immediately turn right into the library parking lot.
